

MEMORIES OF THE FUTURE MU GALLERY SEPT. 19TH-OCT 12TH

"Memories Of Our Future" examines how curation can challenge a sanitized version of history while bringing attention to marginalized groups.

The exhibition is curated by Ren Dillard of Atlanta, GA and it uses the permanent collections of North Dakota State University's to challenge traditional narratives often reinforced by museums and institutions. Through texts, recordings, everyday objects and artwork sequestered to the storage of a vault, Dillard has curated an installation that draws attention to the complex histories of blacks and Native Americans, in affront to familiar historical narratives.





The intent of these informal meetings is to provide a place to discuss graphic design topics, have more engaging conversations, and even critique other's work.







