CO-OP ARCHITECTURE FRIENDS & CITIZENS DESIGN STUDIO | SUMMER 2022

CO-OP Architecture is a South Dakota based design and planning firm dedicated to creating better architecture in our own backyard. In 2019, CO-OP Architecture launched 'Friends & Citizens' - a summer-long, design studio committed to combining the academic and professional world of architecture for interns in any level of education. CO-OP Architecture oversees a group of 3-4 students, offering them the tools and guidance required to complete a theoretical, yet comprehensive, design project. Students will collaborate with various entities, including owners, municipalities or governments, local organizations, and other design consultants. The mission of 'Friends & Citizens' is to have professionals collaborate with students to develop design skills while participating in public policy discussions, developing smart land-use and urban planning strategies, considering sustainability, and most importantly; building vibrant communities. In short, the program wants to improve our neighborhoods and our world as Friends & Citizens. Students in architecture, interior design, landscape architecture, graphic design, construction management, or any other relevant field are all encouraged to apply if interested. Students will be able to participate remotely from our offices in Aberdeen, Rapid City, or Sioux Falls and would focus on tasks related to their respective field. The Friends & Citizens Studio is part of a paid internship experience; 50% of applicants' time will be allocated toward the design studio, while the remaining time will focus on more typical internship duties to ensure a well rounded summer internship experience.

DELIVERABLES

BIM (Revit model), floor plans, sections, elevations, keynoting, finishes, space planning exercises, estimating (material take-off, budgeting, proformas), reflected ceiling plans, furniture layouts, specifications, 3D images, financial opportunities research, code analysis, presentation boards, digital documentation, and any other relevant information.

UNDERGRADUATE

- Enrolled in a construction-related degree program at a school in the United States
- At least one term remaining in a course of study leading to a degree or an associate degree
- Desire a career in a construction related field.
- Be enrolled full-time
- Have a current cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be considered

CONSTRUCTION TRADES

- Enrolled in a construction-related training program which is approved by the Bureau of Apprenticeship Training, community college, technical school or equivalent.
- Must be obtaining training in a construction-related craft or trade

- Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items are emailed to the Foundation and received by February 28th.
