DESIGN DRAFTING COMPETITION APPLICATION TO JOIN DUE DECEMBER 10TH

The Fargo-Moorhead, ND Chapter #246 of the National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC) is sponsoring the NAWIC Education Foundation's (NEF) Design Drafting Competition for the 2020-2021 school year. The contest provides recognition to contestants for their creative design, successful problem-solving skills, and craftsmanship in preparing architectural drawings and renderings. The drawings may be created utilizing any computer aided design (CAD) program available to the contestants, drawn by hand, or may consist of a combination of computer aided and hand drawn drawings. The winner of the local competition will go on to compete in the Regional Competition and the Regional winner will be submitted to compete in NEF's National Competition.

This year, NEF is excited to announce our partnership with project management software company, Procore. Through the site, you will be able to find the Design Drafting documents.
