@ NDSU VIDEO PROJECT - WITH PRIZES! Due friday, march 4th

The Office of Teaching and Learning seeks students (individuals or groups) to participate in this spring's @ NDSU video project! This spring the @ NDSU video project is open to students of any major. Selected proposals will create short workshop videos (10 minutes or less) demonstrating the practical application of a concept in their field of study for a high school student audience. Ideally, these videos will be used by teachers in high school classrooms to teach concepts to students, as well as demonstrate to those students what a visual artist or graphic designer might do as a part of their job.

This event was born out of the pandemic and a desire to be able to share student work with high school students. Our goal is to make the topics approachable for high school students and introduce them to a field of study they might not have otherwise known about or been interested in. Highlighting different areas of study allows these young adults to experience what those disciplines look like in postsecondary education and the real world.

First place will receive a \$100 Gift Card to The NDSU Bookstore, second place will receive a \$50 Gift Card to The NDSU Bookstore, and third place will receive a \$25 Gift Card to The NDSU Bookstore. Criteria for judging will include: engagement, creativity, applicability, teaching, and overall quality.

Video proposals are due no later than Friday, March 4, 2022, but can be sent in before then. The final videos will need to be submitted by Friday, March 11, 2022. We will be posting videos on the Office of Teaching and Learning YouTube page and will be sending the links out to high schools across the state in mid-March.

CALL FOR PROPOSALS: 2022 RAMSA FELLOWSHIP DUE WEDNESDAY, MARCH 30TH

On behalf of Robert A.M. Stern Architects and the RAMSA Fellowship Jury: We are pleased to announce the tenth annual RAMSA Fellowship, a \$10,000 prize awarded by Robert A.M. Stern Architects for travel and research. The fellowship seeks to promote investigations into the perpetuation of tradition through invention. Each year, the fellowship is given to an individual who has proven insight and interest in the profession and its future, as well as the ability to carry forth in-depth research.

We have expanded the list of eligible schools to include all NAAB-accredited schools in the United States. Students in the penultimate year of a graduate-level professional or post-professional degree program in architecture are eligible for the prize, and there is no limit to the number of students who may apply from each school.

Past recipients have traveled to Austria, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Kenya, Poland, Romania, Scotland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Ukraine, and various cities in the United States where they have studied a wide range of topics.

Complete submissions include a research proposal, a portfolio, and the application forms, which must be signed by a school dean or department chair to verify enrollment. Submissions are due on March 30, 2022 and the jury will announce the winner by April 21, 2022.

SUMMER RESEARCH OPPORTUNITY FOR UNDERGRADUATES MAY 31. 2022 TO AUGUST 5. 2022

"Calibrating the Built Environment Using Biosensing Equipment" - Ganapathy Mahalingam, professor, architecture. This summer research experience for undergraduates, involves developing a methodology to calibrate a building (the case study to be used is NDSU's Renaissance Hall) based on use of the building by its inhabitants. The methodology will map various journeys within the building, the steps taken, the calories burned, the floors climbed, pulse rates, and resting pulse rates, using a personal biosensor (the Fitbit device). The researcher will map all possible journeys within the building and record these parameters for each of the journeys by actually making the journeys. The data will then be processed and be used to create a calibration of the building based on its effectiveness to promote wellness through physical activity. The purpose of the research project is to develop this methodology for the calibration of a building to indicate how it supports wellness through physical activity. The goal is to develop a system that is similar to the energy efficiency rating of buildings and provides a wellness score for the building.

The stipend for the 10-week research program is a maximum of \$6000, working 40 hours a week. Plus \$500 for consumables related to the research. In addition, living accommodations in one of the residence halls and funds for travel to and from Fargo may be available. This is open to undergraduate students only and there are eligibility requirements. You need to apply for this opportunity and go through a selection process. 
