2023 NDRM & CPA SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

NDSU Architecture Students Rachel Monsebroten and Koy Olson attended the North Dakota Ready Mix and Concrete Products Association Awards Banquet on January 12th to accept their scholarship awards for their commitment to and recognition of importance of concrete in their professional future.



Congratulations to the following students who earned scholarships from the NDRM&CPA Scholarship Program. These students have shown a commitment to educational excellence and the recognition of the importance of concrete in their professional future. Each scholarship recipient will receive 52,000 to use toward their continued education.



Rachel Monsebroten is a Graduate Student pursuing her Master of Architecture degree from North Dakota State University in Fargo. Monsebroten, a Grafton, ND natwe, holds a 4.0 GPA in both of her undergraduate and graduate course studies. As stated in her application, Rachel is excited about the use of concrete as part of her daily life as a design professional, and currently utilizes it on various projects while pursing her graduate degree.



Koy Olson is a Junior at North Dakota State University, pursuing an undergraduate degree in Architecture. Olson, a Buxton, North Dakota native, holds a 3.91 GPA. Koy has spent the last 3 summers working as a construction laborer and most recently, an architectural intern for hepper Olson Architects. In his application, Olson recognized how concrete is used in many facets of our daily lives and how it will affect his future design decisions.



Joe Useldinger is a Grand Forks, ND native and is currently pursuing his Masters of Science degree in Civil Engineering at the University of North Dakota in Grand Forks. Useldinger currently holds a 10 GPA in his graduate coursework. Joe has spent previous summers working for NDRM&CPA member Braun Intertec as a Materials Testing intern in Bismarck. Useldinger currently has a pending publication to TRB on the sustainability of concrete when exposed to varying decing chimicals and is the co-author on a published paper about the substitutions of fine aggregate and cement with bottom ash and ground bottom ash. More orably, Joe has a current project for the University sponsored by the City of Grand Forks to investigate the impacts decing chemicals have on hardned properties of concrete and freeze and thaw impacts after different curing techniques.

The NDRM&CPA Scholarship Program was established in 1993. Applicants must be junior, senior or graduate students in civil engineering, construction engineering, construction management, architecture, or landscape architecture. They are awarded points on work or internship experience; grade-point-average; campus or industry involvement; and a four-part, written essay regarding the benefits of concrete. With the 2023 Scholarship Awards, the program has given out 512,000 to 97 students.

We want to thank all students who applied for a scholarship and for the time and effort that went into their applications. Also, a special thanks to the scholarship committee and to our industry partners who alligently help with fundnasing efforts to make this scholarship argorium a continued success.


COLLECTIVE IDENTITIES: SELECTIONS FROM ART 380 ADVANCED PHOTO (FALL 2022) January 17 - February 3rd

Now on display in the Flakoll Gallery of Renaissance Hall, selected works from Art 380, Advanced Photography, Fall 2022. The included photographs and videos are reflections on Identity, collective and personal. Each body of work explores a different aspect of Collective Identity from the point of view of the maker. With Identity as the conceptual primer, participants were encouraged to explore technical aspects of light and shadow, and how this can guide compositional decisions. Participants worked with a range of tools and media, from analog film photography to digital image capture, from still imagery to video, with new and revised content. There is even some thread in there!

Participating artists include Hayden Austin, Malcolm Strand, Sammy Trevis, Taiyler Rall, Jacob Reiner, Alyssa Trosen, and Jenni Lavin.

ARCHITECTURAL THEORY EXHIBITION DECEMBER 8TH - FEBRUARY 20TH

The second-year students in the Contemporary Architecture and Theory class created a very nice exhibition in the Klai Hall Library. There are actually two exhibitions on display at the same time: Postcards and Book Covers. The postcards are manifestos reflecting drawing, collage, writing, photography, sketching, or a combination thereof. The architecture students articulate their architectural ideas on a single postcard. creating about 16 postcards working in groups or four. The book covers have been made in groups of two and there are about 32 book covers or so. The idea is to read a book selected from a list of 64 books in architectural theory, philosophy, poetry, art, or architectural drawing and then express the content and their findings and build and construct a book cover. The exhibition is on display on the circulation desk in the library in Klai Hall until the 20th of February 2023.


